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SOLENT TO SUSSEX BAY SEASCAPE RESTORATION INVENTORY

The central south coast of England is home to a huge amount of active and planned marine and coastal restoration projects. It is also the focus of extensive restoration research activities. However, available inventory of projects, have made it hard for stakeholders to collaborate with all restoration practitioners and researchers in the Solent to Sussex Bay area.

To begin to tackle this gap, a network of south coast universities as well as several public and private sector organisations have established the Solent to Sussex Bay Seascape Restoration Network across the restoration projects and researchers in this area.

To help us and others understand this work, the Solent to Sussex Bay Seascape Restoration Network, in collaboration with the Solent Forum, and Sussex Marine and Coastal Forum are developing a completed seascape restoration projects and research in the Solent to Sussex Bay area. The inventory will provide interested stakeholders with the key information needed to learn from, and engage with all restoration practitioners and researchers in the Solent to Sussex Bay area. Once compiled, the inventory will be freely available online (expected Spring 2023) through the Solent Forum and Sussex Marine and Coastal Forum.
