## Professor Mike Clark Award, 2017

### Thinking about a Dissertation with a Solent Coastal Theme?

You could be eligible for the Solent Forum Bursary award. Gain up to £200 towards your research costs and the prestige of an award for your CV.

The award is open to undergraduate and postgraduate students. Your proposed project must have a coastal theme and focus totally or partially on the Solent coastal region (east of Christchurch Harbour to Selsey Bill and the Isle of Wight). Subjects can be highly varied and in the past have included recreation, conservation, physical processes, pollution, marine industry and more.



### 2016 Winner Topics

- Establishing the roles of stakeholders and the community in flood risk management at Chichester Harbour, addressing the potential for alternative strategies.
- Project on protected broodstock cages attached to existing floating structures as a viable source of larvae to contribute to the re-population of the native oyster, *Ostrea edulis*, in the Solent.
- Quantification of microplastics in populations of *Ostrea edulis* in the Solent.
- Project on sub barrier consolidation and implications for natural or managed realignment of a gravel barrier.
